Woe to you who are well fed now, for you will go hungry. Woe to you who laugh now, for you will mourn and weep. (Luke 6:25)



Churches that truly follow Christ will not use gimmicks, such as Hell Houses or Harvest alternative parties, in the attempt to promote Christianity and draw youth into their groups.

This is what we speak, not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit, expressing spiritual truths in spiritual words. (1 Corinthians 2:13)

For they mouth empty, boastful words and, by appealing to the lustful desires of sinful human nature, they entice people who are just escaping from those who live in error. They promise them freedom, while they themselves are slaves of depravity—for a man is a slave to whatever has mastered him. (2 Peter 2:18-19)


True Christians are considered strange because they do not behave like the world.

(Exodus 32:5-6)





Christians do not "cross over" to the world. Instead they preach the cross of Christ and invite the world to cross over from death to life.

You adulterous people, don't you know that friendship with the world is hatred toward God? Anyone who chooses to be a friend of the world becomes an enemy of God. (James 4:4)

True Christians do not dress up in costumes on Halloween night.

... snatch others from the fire and save them; to others show mercy, mixed with fear—hating even the clothing stained by corrupted flesh. (Jude 1:23)
